FORMAT:

Contestants will perform any TWO Mozart compositions originally written for solo voice. These may include songs, concert arias, solo pieces from choral works, & opera arias. **Selections must be performed in their entirety, from memory & with piano accompaniment. Total performance time not to exceed 8 minutes.**

Three evaluators will provide comments and evaluations of each performance at the Competition Preliminaries. Three different evaluators will determine the prize winners at the Competition Final.

GENERAL RULES/ELIGIBILITY:

1. Applicants must reside in Southern California & be 30 years or younger on January 11, 2010.
2. Finalists must provide proof of residency & age.
3. Finalists must be available to perform on January 23, 2010.
4. Prizes to be awarded at judges’ discretion.
5. Previous Grand Prize winners are not eligible.

APPLICATION/ENTRY FEE/DEADLINE:

There is a non-refundable entry fee of \$35. Please include your professional resume. The Festival will furnish an accompanist for an additional \$25 or contestants may provide their own accompanist. **Please return the completed application form (below), entry fee & accompanist’s fee (if any) postmarked no later than January 2, 2010.**
