Winners may be invited to perform at the Prelude Event in May or June 2012.

Three judges will provide written comments and evaluations of each performance at the Competition Preliminaries. Three different evaluators will determine the prize winners at the Final Competition.

Contestants will be evaluated both on technical ability and musical interpretative skills.

Rules:

1. Contestants will perform any TWO Mozart compositions originally written for solo voice. These may include songs, concert arias, solo pieces from choral works, & opera arias. Selections must be performed in their entirety, from memory & with piano accompaniment. Total performance time not to exceed 8 minutes.
2. Applicants must be 30 years or younger on January 14, 2012 and reside in Southern California. Finalists may be asked provide proof of age and residency.
3. Finalists must be available to perform on January 14, 2012.
4. Previous 1st Prize winners are not eligible.
5. No photography, video, or audio recording is permitted at Festival events.

ENTRY FEE/DEADLINE:

There is a non-refundable entry fee of \$45. Please include your professional resume.
